
Estimated Rice Production in 2025

- ☐ The total rice production is estimated to record 3.574 million tons in 2025, which dropped by 11 thousand tons ($\triangle 0.3\%$) from 3.585 million tons in 2024.
- O Cultivated area: 698 thousand hectares in 2024 \rightarrow 678 thousand hectares in 2025 (\triangle 2.9%)
- O Production per 10a: 514kg in 2024 \rightarrow 527kg in 2025 (2.7%)
- O Total production: 3.585 million tons in 2024 \rightarrow 3.574 million tons in 2025 (\triangle 0.3%)

< Trend in the cultivated area and production of rice by year >


1. Estimated Rice Production of the Nation

- □ The rice production is estimated to record 3.574 million tons in 2025, falling by 11 thousand tons ($\triangle 0.3\%$) from 3.585 million tons in 2024.
- O Estimated rice production (the ratio of brown rice to white rice at 92.9%): 3.585 million tons in $2024 \rightarrow 3.574$ million tons in 2025
 - * Estimated rice production when applying the ratio of brown rice to white rice at 90.4%: 3.488 million tons in $2024 \rightarrow 3.478$ million tons in 2025
- O The total rice production is estimated to fall by 11 thousand tons ($\triangle 0.3\%$) from the previous year due to the decrease in the cultivated area ($\triangle 2.9\%$).


< Trend in the cultivated area and production of rice by year >

- ☐ The cultivated area of rice totaled 678 thousand hectares in 2025, which declined by 2.9% from 698 thousand hectares in 2024.
 - O The cultivated area of rice showed a decrease owing to government policies* to produce the appropriate quantity of rice for the balance between rice supply and demand.

- * Direct payment program for strategic crops, non-rice paddy crop support project (by local governments), etc.
- □ The rice production per 10a is estimated to record 527kg in 2025, rising by 2.7% from 514kg in 2024.
 - O Estimated rice production per 10a (the ratio of brown rice to white rice at 92.9%): 514kg in $2024 \rightarrow 527$ kg in 2025
 - * Rice production per 10a when applying the ratio of brown rice to white rice at 90.4%: 500kg in $2024 \rightarrow 513$ kg in 2025
 - O The rice production per 10a is estimated to record a year-on-year increase owing to an increase in the number of ears per root and the number of whole grains per m², which resulted from favorable weather conditions including sunshine hours during the June-August period.
 - Number of ears per root: 21.0 ears in 2024 \rightarrow 22.1 ears in 2025 (1.1 ear \uparrow)
 - Number of whole grains per m^2 : 29,628 grains in 2024 \rightarrow 30,220 grains in 2025 (592 grains \uparrow)
 - · Sunshine hours (June ~ August): 634.5 hours in 2024 → 662.7 hours in 2025

2. Estimated Rice Production by Province

□ As for rice production by province, Jeonnam recorded the highest figure at 704 thousand tons, which was followed by Chungnam (697 thousand tons) and Jeonbuk (546 thousand tons).
