# Economically Active Population Survey in September 2025

#### <Economically active population and labor force participation rate>

- The economically active population marked 29.788 million persons in September, which grew 324 thousand persons or 1.1% year-on-year.
- $\circ$  The labor force participation rate stood at 65.0% in September, up 0.4%p year-on-year.

#### <Employed persons and employment to population ratio>

- The number of employed persons totaled 29.154 million persons in September, which went up 312 thousand persons or 1.1% year-on-year.
- The employment to population ratio recorded 63.7% in September, up 0.4%p year-on-year.

#### <Unemployed persons and unemployment rate>

- The number of unemployed persons totaled 635 thousand people in September, which increased 12 thousand persons or 2.0% year-on-year.
- The unemployment rate marked 2.1% in September, remaining the same year-on-year.

### <Economically inactive population>

• The economically inactive population totaled 16.009 million people in September, decreasing 116 thousand persons or 0.7% year-on-year.
